

SOFTNESS OF WOOL, PURITY OF PAPER, GLOW OF COPPER... WOODNOTES COLLECTION 2007 ON SHOW IN MILAN

Woodnotes, founded in 1987 by Ritva and Mikko Puotila, is known for its uncompromisingly pure and clean line of paper yarn carpets, fabrics, accessories and unique works. Woodnotes is presenting its 2007 collection at the International Furnishing Accessories Exhibition in Milan on April 18-23. New innovative Woodnotes items are extensively on show at stand no. E 10 in Pavilion 12.

New items in collection 2007

Archipelago wool paper carpets by Ritva Puotila combine the best characteristics of wool and paper in one product. The colours are derived from the Finnish archipelago. Backing on the reverse side and edges finished with a narrow cotton or leather border make this product ideal for both home and public use. Archipelago carpets were nominated for the interior innovation award at the IMM fair in Cologne in January.

Coast paper yarn carpets give almost one coloured impression which has been created by blending two colours in the weave. Coast carpets are available with edging and as contract carpets. Design Ritva Puotila.

Vista blind and partition fabric both covers and reveals. The rhythm of stripes in the weave comes from the combination of paper yarn and cotton. Vista is available in three colours: white, white/natural and white/stone. Vista is also used for place mats and table runners. Design Ritva Puotila.

Flake interior element by Mia Cullin can be used to make different surfaces for curtains, partitions and table decorations. Even three-dimensional forms are possible. The pieces are easy to join and the surface can be redone and undone. The material is Tyvek®. Flake interior element was granted an interior innovation award in the Materials Innovation category at the IMM fair in Cologne in January.

Woodnotes studio collection offers a line of handmade items. Mesh is a handmade knit of paper and copper. Seaborn knits made of 100 % paper yarn are available in eight colours. Fisherman scarves are hand-knitted from fine linen. The delicious colour chart varies from light transparent tones to intensive dark colours. Design Ritva Puotila.

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
